## **Current Clinical Practice**

Specialist Neuro Occupational Therapist with Munro Therapy Services.

My background is in Neuro Paediatrics – I have 25 years experience in this area with my main speciality being babies who are born early. I set up a service on Bolton's Neonatal Unit and a community follow up service in 2001.

I work holistically with the families I've had on my caseload, many of whom use the word 'family' when referring to me. Paediatrics involves supporting the child and their parents/guardians with their physical, perceptual, sensory, mental and emotional wellbeing. It includes supporting at the child's home, often involving siblings, and in their educational settings as a minimum.

I am used to working alongside a large multidisciplinary team including the medical team, education staff, the local authority on housing adaptations, etc.

I am experienced in applying for the Disabled Facilities Grant for families who need adaptations to properties and I am used to working with the Local Authority's architects and building surveyors.

I am skilled at assessing specialist equipment in bathing, seating, beds/cots, sleep systems.

I am skilled in the use of standardised and non-standardised assessments for motor and visual perceptual skills as well as handwriting. I am trained in specific baby assessments including NBAS and AIMS.

I provide assessment, treatment and recommendations in support of a huge array of motor issues for 0-19 years including Dyspraxia, Cerebral Palsy from PMLD to hemiplegia, Hypermobility, ADHD, many different syndromes, etc.

I provide equipment and advice to aid daily living tasks. This includes kitchen accessories, specialist pencil grips for writing (or assessment of alternatives to writing) help with bathing, toileting, and providing sensory aids in school to help children coping in school environments.

I am competent in creating hand splints; I have even splinted (hand and foot) babies on the NNU.

I am trained in assessment and provision of moving and handling equipment such as hoists and slings.

I am competent in providing documentation for legal documents such as EHCP's.

I am wheelchair accredited.

I am used to managing a caseload of upwards of 120 children.

I have been MAPA trained 22-23

I have the first level of Sensory Integration Training.
